Named for Francesco Zantedeschia who wrote about Italian plants around 1825.

Simple Beauty

Zantedeschia

Long, sinuous, trumpet-shaped with a tapering tip and often a colored throat – Zantedeschia (Z Calla) makes an elegant focal point in an arrangement.

COLOR RANGE: Hues include white, yellow, orange, pink, red, burgundy, black and bicolors. Growing conditions affect plant coloring, so two flowers of the same variety may have slightly different coloration within a bunch or from planting to planting.

FARM FRESH: Our Zantedeschia is sustainably grown in glass greenhouses and in hoop houses.

BUNCHES: Standard bunch size: 10 stems. Consumer Bunches of 3 and 5 stems are available.

LASTING: Zantedeschia have a great vase life – keeping their beauty for about 2 weeks.

LENGTH: Bloom sizes average 4", on 20" to 30" stem lengths.

CARE & HANDLING: Upon arrival, diagonally cut stems and place into a clean container with fresh, tepid water and fresh flower food solution. Keep in cool location out of direct sunlight and drafts. Replenish water as needed and recut stem ends periodically.
